Our hub in Hersham is at the heart of our retail operations. Donations are centrally stored at the hub and then distributed to our 40+ shops across our care community.

We are looking for volunteers to assist us in sorting and organising supporter donations and keeping the hub running smoothly on a day to day basis.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

If you would enjoy meeting supporters and organising and sorting donations for sale then this could be the role for you!

Activities will include:

- Receiving donations supporters drop off at the hub
- Promoting Gift Aid on the goods donated
- Assisting with the moving, handling and cleaning of stock as required
- Organising stock into seasons
- Bagging any unsaleable stock ready for the bag merchant
- Identifying items to be sold online
- Working with colleagues to keep the hub well organised and tidy
